Chad, take to our fellowship the pamphlets we got today and we can purchase at an affordable cost. Julie, does this replace the single sheet of meeting schedule? Jay why? Chad, no. Bob have both. Let the fellowship have the option. Dan, are we talking about printing these, Bob yes, Dan, I can print them at my office. Fellowship not paying for the single sheet. K. K. brought up that at the last meeting Ruth brought in the old CVIAA hand book to see if the board wanted to update and make revisions. There was not a decision made at the last business meeting.
